Services are organised and operated by LMCTG. It provides services in both the Marrickville and Leichhardt municipalities.

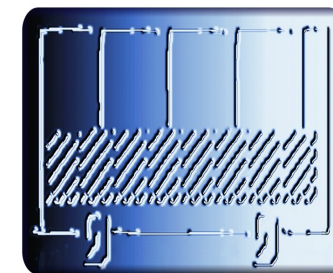

What is it?

It's a transport service that takes individuals from their homes to a wide variety of destinations and brings them home afterwards.

The service builds and extends from other Leichhardt Marrickville Community Transport Group services, allowing a greater array of destinations, times and levels of assistance.

We consider requests depending on your needs and our resources.

Who is it designed for?

Generally people who are older, or who have a disability and who are living independently. Their carers travel for free. Contact the office for details.

The service is designed to assist residents of Leichhardt and Marrickville municipalities 'get around' – those who can't use or have difficulty using more 'ordinary' transport such as buses or taxis.

Do passengers receive assistance?

Drivers will assist clients in/out the vehicle if required.

Specialised assistance may also be available if discussed in advance with the office. This may include staying with you for the entire trip etc. You could also consider taking your Carer.

Where does it go to?

You decide. Generally the service will take you to any destination within the greater Sydney region. Make an enquiry and the office can advise you.

When does it operate?

You'll need to check date/time availability with the office in advance. The service generally does not operate on a weekend or night.

How much does it cost?

The transport cost varies depending on distances/times etc. The office will supply you a quote in advance. Fees are negotiable if you face financial hardship.

What do I need to know before I start?

- You must be ready when the driver calls and follow his/her directions.
- In exceptional circumstances, services may be cancelled due to mechanical breakdowns, staff illness etc.
- Clients requiring medical treatment can combine additional trips from other services.
- Please ensure to book your trip in advance to obtain the date and time you want.

Who can use the service?

- They are available to eligible residents of Marrickville and Leichhardt municipalities.
- All services require an easy, over the phone assessment to ascertain if you are eligible prior to receiving any service.
- Generally, services are available to people who are older, or who have an illness or disability that makes ordinary transport difficult. Carers travel free of charge.
- The services are designed to assist people who don't or can't drive, cannot arrange transport through a friend/relative, cannot use public transport or afford taxis.
